Thank you for your request for information dated 27/09/2022 about GLA High Streets For All Challenge -funding agreements follow up. We have dealt with this under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

### **Response**

The council holds the information requested. The answers to your questions are below.

**You mention that £10000 were drawn by Camden Council following the stage 2 agreement. Could you please provide the date, as originally requested, of when these £10000 were drawn?**

At the request of the GLA, an invoice for an initial £10,000 was sent by Camden to the GLA on 1st February 2022.

**On the point 3 of my request, I was referring to the " costed development plan" that had to be submitted by May/June the latest by Camden to the GLA and Power to change as per the attached document. Please supply the above mentioned agreed and costed development plan relating to the Community Improvement District.**

The costed development plan that forms part of the work to pilot a Community Improvement District in Kilburn is still being drafted and has not yet been shared with Power to Change and the Greater London Authority. It is expected that the costed development plan will be shared with Power to Change and the GLA within the next 1-2 months.
